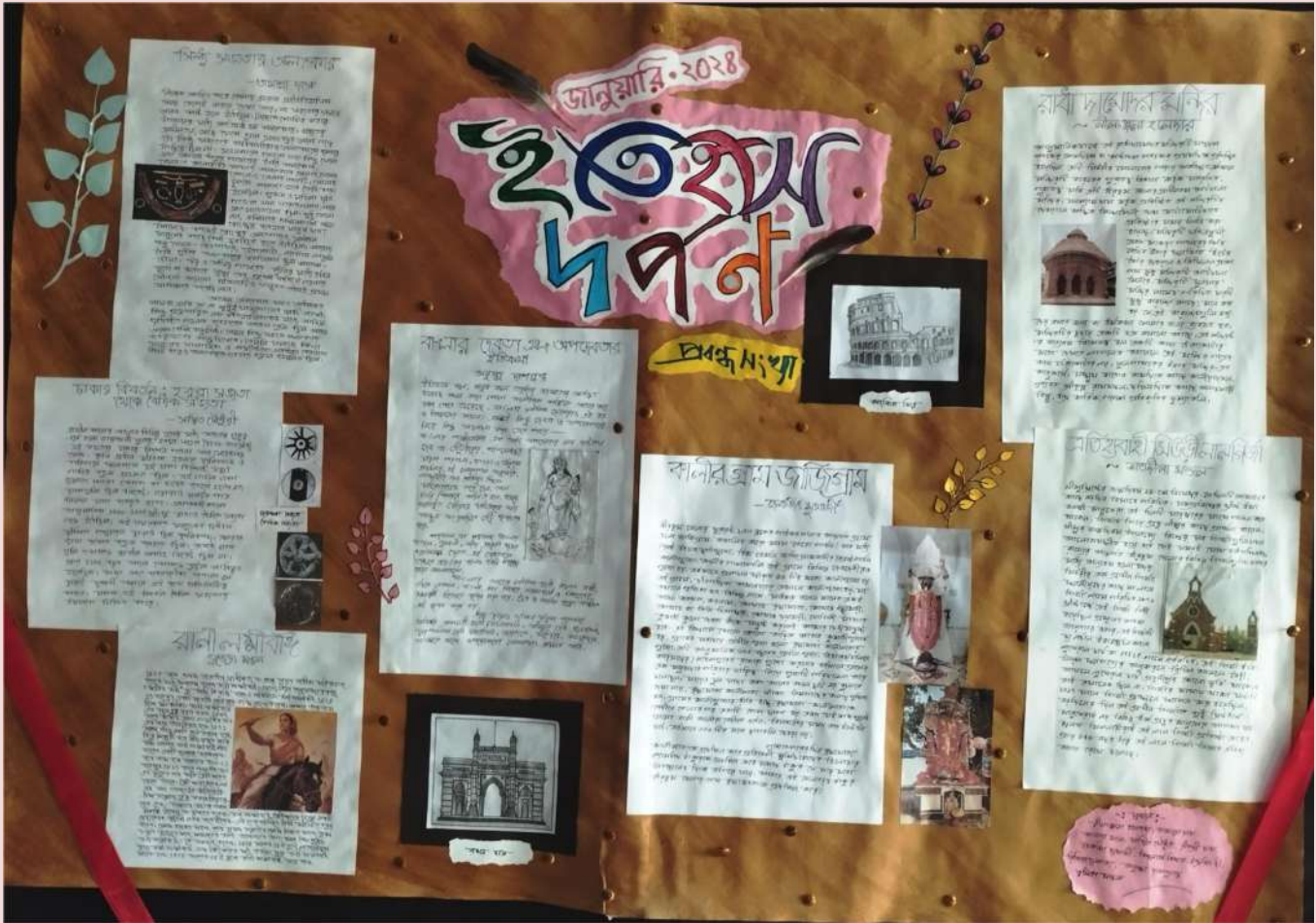

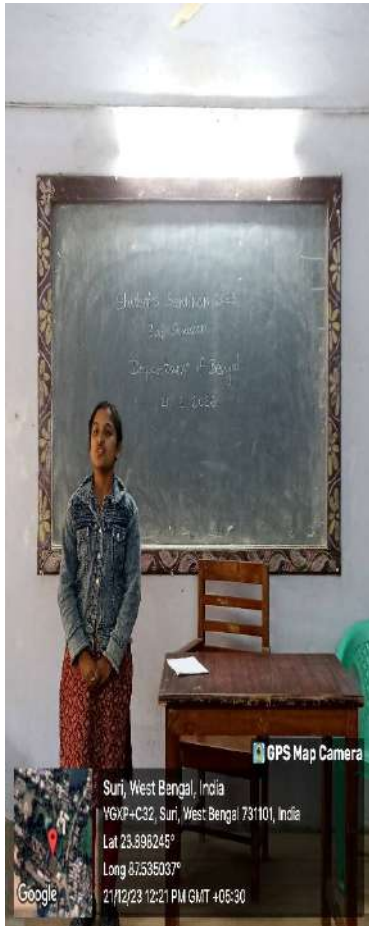

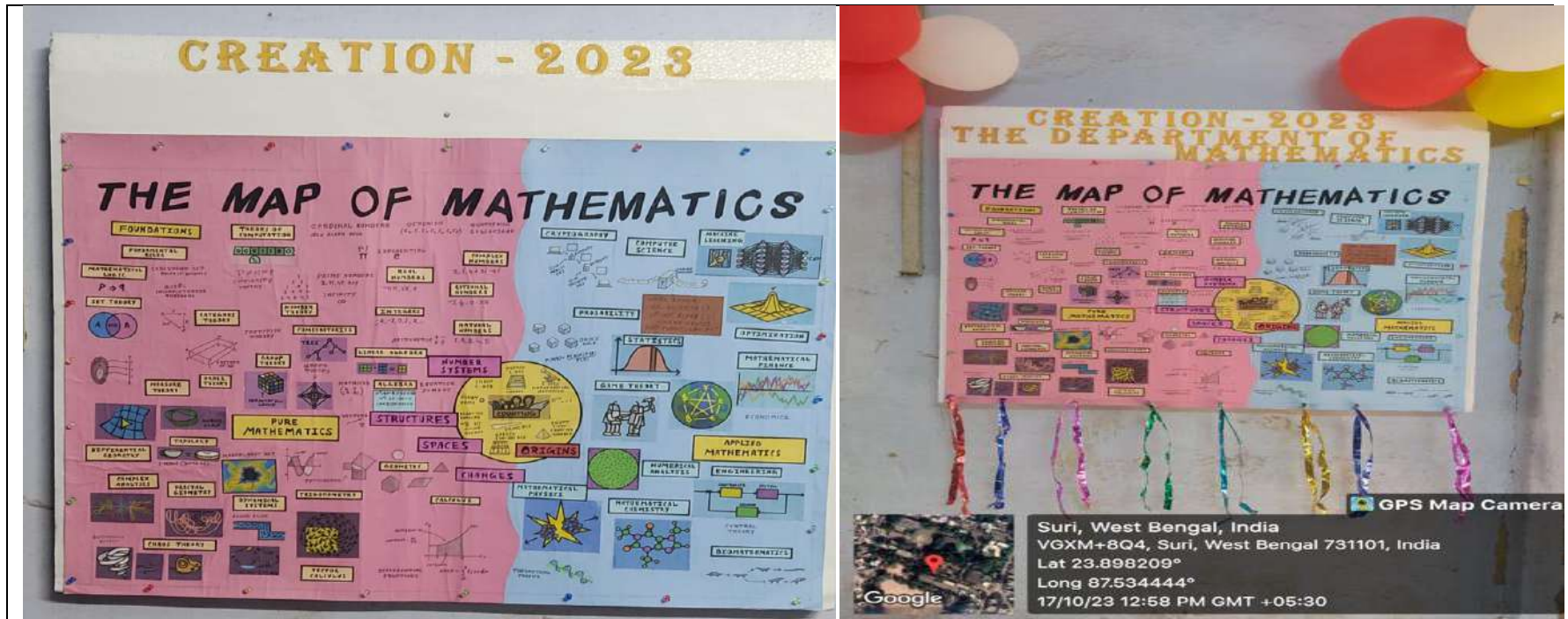

DENGUE

Dengue is a febrile illness caused by a flavivirus transmitted by *Aedes aegypti* or *Aedes albopictus* mosquitoes while taking a blood meal. There are four dengue virus (DENV) types (DENV-1, DENV-2, DENV-3, DENV-4), all of which are capable of inducing severe disease. Dengue is endemic in more than 115 countries in tropical and subtropical regions and causes an estimated 390 million infections annually worldwide.

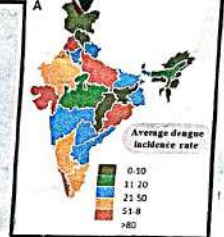

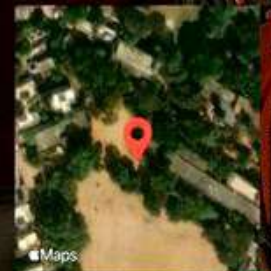

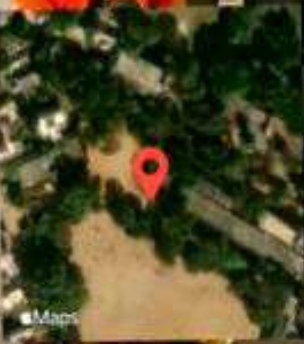
